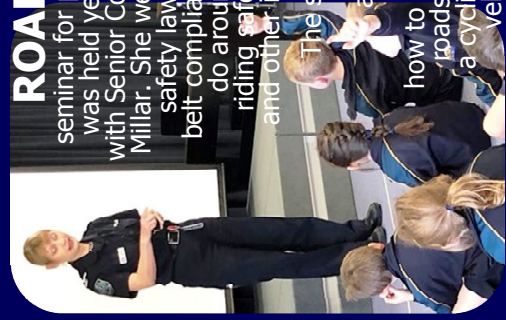
BUNNINGS BARBECUE SATURDAY 18 MAY
