WE HAVE APPROVAL FOR SENIOR SECONDARY!

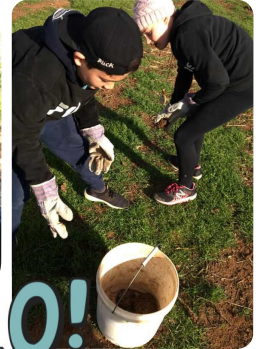

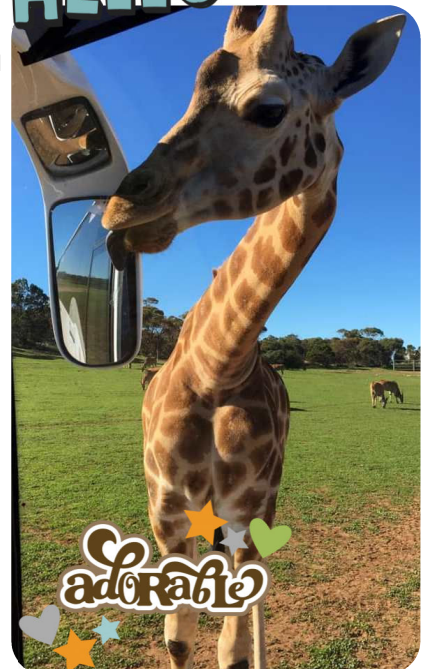
Fun
