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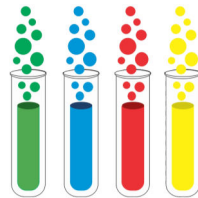
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NATIONAL SCIENCE WEEK

We have been having such fun learning about God's world from a scientific perspective this week! Our Head of Secondary Mr Schumann, with some awesome help from the Year 9/10 class, has led presentations and experiments on lots of different topics including geology, chemistry and physics, along with in-class studies across the school.



The students have interacted with the principles of rocket propulsion (Newton's third law of motion, mass & momentum), the dynamic properties of liquids and gases at varying temperatures (including dry ice), forces, density, buoyancy... and that was just at lunchtimes! Many more topics and observations were carried out in class to explore and examine the phenomenal world around us—**check out more videos and pics on our Facebook page.**

A HUGE THANKS to Mr Schumann, the 9/10 student assistants, Accolade Wines (Berri Estates) for donating the dry ice, Mrs Huckel for capturing the action on video and all the students who joined in to make Science Week so incredible. May the learning continue!
