Primary school students: Have you got your Wind in the Willows costume ready yet? **They need to be brought in on Monday please.**

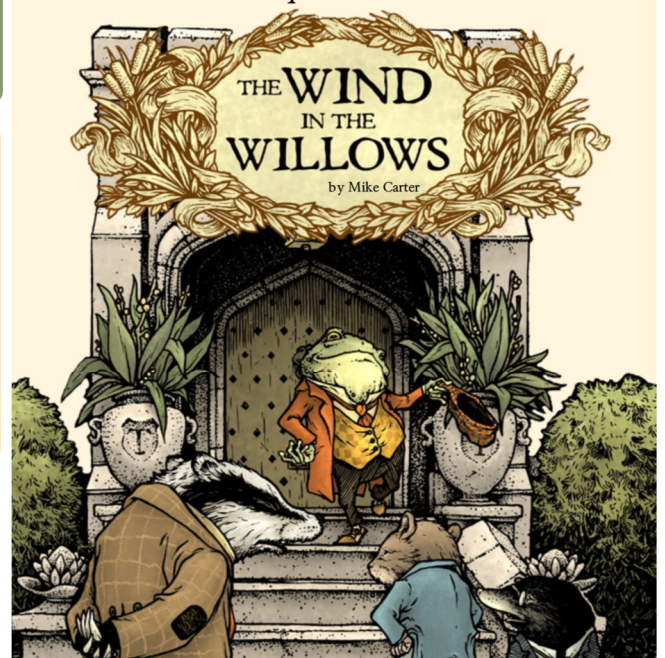
F/1: Brown pants/white shirts with red/green jacket or scarf
